## AGATHA CHRISTIE

Agatha Christie is an English detective novelist. She is known throughout the world as the Queen of Crime. Agatha Christie was born in 1891. Her father died

when she was little. She did not attend school and was tutored at home by her mother.

She worked in the Red Cross Hospital as a nurse at the outbreak of 1914 war. There she gained very good knowledge of poisons which helped her later in her literary work. Agatha Christie wanted to be an opera singer, but instead started writing in response to a challenge from her sister.

In her first book "The Mysterious Affair at Styles" she created the now famous Belgian detective, Hercule Poirot, who is as popular as Conan Doyle's Sherlock Holmes.

Hercule Poirot is a small, bald man with a large moustache and a very neat appearance. He thinks the English are strange, while the English think that his way of speaking English is funny. He is very clever and always discovers who the criminal is.

The other very famous character is Miss Marple. She is a respectable, polite old lady who is also very clever at explaining mysteries and discovering criminals, especially murderers.

Agatha Christie wrote over 70 detective novels and many short stories and plays.

Her two best-known books are "Murder on the Orient Express" and "Death on the Nile".

Many of her stories have been filmed, including "Witness for the Prosecution" which starred Marlene Dietrich.

Her play "Mousetrap", a thriller, which opened in London in 1952 is the longest running show in the world. It has been performed over 16 000 times.

Agatha Christie died at the age of 85.
