Intensive English Program (IEP) www.pittstate.edu/iep

- Established Intensive English Program offering six levels of instruction ranging from elementary to academic preparation
- Full-time language instruction and pre-academic training featuring five, eight-week sessions during the year
- Sessions offered: August-October, October-December, January-March, March-May, and June-July
- Students who successfully graduate from IEP may begin their college coursework at PSU (exceptions: Psychology and English)

International Admission Requirements

International applicants are evaluated for admission based on the following criteria: (for more information visit www.pittstate.edu/international)

Academic Qualifications and Credentials

The applicant's academic record is required. SAT/ACT scores are not required for undergraduate international students with a grade point average at 75% of highest score. GRE required for Psychology and Counseling graduate programs only. GMAT or GRE required for MBA students.

English Language Proficiency

In order to begin academic programs at Pittsburg State, all international students must submit an official, passing TOEFL, IELTS or PTE score. Students who do not submit such a score will be required to enroll in and successfully complete PSU's Intensive English Program (IEP) prior to beginning academic coursework. TOFFI .

- Score of at least 68* (internet), 520 (paper), or 190 (computer) is required
- Some areas of undergraduate and graduate study may require a higher TOEFL score
- Institutional TOEFL scores not accepted

*15 each band

IELTS:

- Minimum of 5.0 required in each band (6.0 overall)
- Some areas of study may require a higher IELTS score

PTE:

- Score of 47 required
- Some areas of study may require a higher PTE score

Admission Checklist

Step 1: Complete online application: www.pittstate.edu/admission

Step 2: Pay non-refundable application fee.

Undergraduate fee: \$50; Graduate fee: \$60; IEP fee: \$50

Step 3: Submit official school records (transcripts) from each secondary school attended for undergraduate (bachelor's) applicants and each post-secondary school for graduate (master's) school applicants.

Step 4: Submit official TOEFL, IELTS or PTE score results (if available).*

Step 5: Submit statement of financial support and certified bank statement or financial guarantee.

Step 6: Submit copy of passport.

Supporting application documents may be emailed to **i-admit@ pittstate.edu** for preliminary use only. Official transcripts must be mailed directly to Pittsburg State University from the issuing institution.

No ACT or SAT is required for international admission.

* Conditional admission is possible if applicant does not have the TOEFL, IELTS or PTE score. Enrollment in the Intensive English Program is required.


