

Requirements for papers

1. The paper should not exceed 1 author's sheet containing 40,000 characters. Tables and figures should be included within the text of the paper.
2. Text preparation:
 - Paper should contain a short abstract of several lines length;
 - All tables and figures in the text or its appendices should have a caption. They should be referred to in the text.
 - Black and white figures should have a caption. Lettering and symbols should be clearly defined either in the caption or in a legend provided as part of the figure according to standards to be found in "Author's guidelines".
3. References must be listed at the end of the paper. References to sources are listed in the text in their order of appearance in square brackets. The description of literary sources should include: author's or authors' names and initials, title of the paper, place of publication, publisher, and year (if journal, newspaper - name, year, issue). Referring to unpublished results is forbidden. When analyzing modern economy of Russia and of the Republic of Tatarstan, it is necessary to refer to the latest publishing data.
4. The paper should enclose the following information about the author (s): surname, first name, patronymic; academic degree and title; place of work, job title; office and home phones.
5. Author should also provide the email address to be used for suggestions and corrections in the paper (according to the copyright law).
6. Papers that do not meet the requirements will not be considered.
