## **General information**

Nikolay Lobachevsky Academic Library offers access to a vast collection of print and electronic publications in English and other European languages.

Print publications. In the reading hall number 1 (35 Kremlevskaya str., 4th floor),



you can access more than 2500 publications covering all fields of knowledge, primarily philosophy, sociology, culture, jurisprudence, economics, and other areas of social and humanitarian sciences.



**Electronic resources.** You can find electronic resources (e-resources) from the world's leading scientific publishers and search aggregators. These resources are available as collections of journals and books, namely:

Resources covered by the Library's subscription are freely available from any computer connected to KFU network.


To access the above-mentioned resources from a computer that is not connected to KFU network (remote access), you should follow the instructions given below to set up a VPN service.

# Instructions to create a VPN connection to KFU network


To create a VPN connection to KFU network, you should do the following:

1. Click the Start button. In the menu that opens, click on Control Panel.


2. Click on Control Panel in the address bar.




3. In the new window, click on Network 4. In the window that opens, click and Internet. on Network and Sharing Center.

6. Now select Connect to a workplace and 7. Click on Use my Internet connection click the Next button. (VPN).





