# Rating system for assessing the knowledge of students in the discipline "Pathological Anatomy"

in the specialties "General Medicine", "Dentistry", "Medical Biochemistry", "Medical Biophysics"

Points during the 5th semester of the 3rd course preceding the intermediate certification are distributed as follows:

## **0-20 points** - written work on topics 1-7.

#### **0-20 points** - control work on topics 8-12 (oral form).

**0-10 points** - the average score for the current activity (oral answers, tests).

**Total** for the 5th semester: 20+20+10=**50 points**.

The intermediate test is estimated at 28-50 points.

Students who scored less than 28 points for the test are considered not to have passed the test.

"Passed" are received by students who have scored a total of 56 points or more for the 5th semester.

Points during **the 6th semester** preceding the exam are distributed as follows:

**0-20 points** - written work on topics 13-20.

**0-20 points** - written work on topics 13-20.

## **0-20 points** - control work on topics 22-27 (oral form).

**0-10 points** - the average score for the current activity (oral answers, tests).

**Total** for the 6th semester: 20+20+10=**50 points**.

#### The exam consists of:

- 1. practical part (diagnosticum on micropreparations) **0-20 points**.
- 2. theoretical part (in the form of an interview on tickets) **0-30 points**.

The exam is estimated at 28-50 points.

Students who score **less than 28 points** in the exam are considered *not to have passed* the exam.

The final grade in the discipline "Pathological Anatomy" is put down in the student's record book if the student scores a total of 56 points or more for the 6th semester and the exam.

# Rating upgrade

The situation when the student passed the exam with 28 points or more, scored 56 points or more in total, but wants to improve the final result.

In this case, the student receives a second examination ticket, each question is scored  $\bf 0$  -  $\bf 15$  points.

## **Addition of points**

The situation when the student passed the exam with 28 points or more, but did not score 56 points in total.

In this case, the student receives a second examination ticket, each question is scored **0** - **15 points**. However, the addition stops when a total of 56 points is reached, which will be the maximum score in this situation.

Passes are not worked out, control and written works, diagnosticum on micropreparations are not retaken.
