

The strategic objective of Kazan Federal University is to enhance its prestige, raise academic and R&D reputation, and achieve a high international level of its academic programs and global leadership in the priority research areas in order to enter the world Top-100 universities.


Integration of Kazan Federal University (hereinafter - KFU) into international academic and research environment as well setting its positions at the international level are provided for through the implementation of the following mechanisms: development of partnerships and network cooperation with leading universities, world research centers and organizations; invitation of international staff members and students; extending mutual academic mobility; participation at international projects and collaborations, entering international academic alliances and associations, holding at KFU international high-impact events and carrying out target-oriented information campaign.

ACADEMIC EXPORT

One of the main priority areas of Kazan Federal University's activity makes the development of **academic export** leading to continuous growth of the number of international students at university and providing for KFU being amongst top Russian universities as far as this indicator is concerned. **9 654** international students from **106** countries took their studies at KFU in 2019: including **8 717** taking main educational programs (Bachelor, Master, Specialist degrees), **192** enrolled in postgraduate studies and **8** were the students of Residency. The split according to the form of studies was the following: government scholarship (special quota) based studies – 682, budget-funded studies – 643, tuition fee-based studies – 7592. The percentage of international students among the general number of students taking studies under main educational programs (Bachelor, Master, Specialist degrees) has reached 22% (18, 8 % at the main University) in the reporting year.

The countries of Central Asia, including Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, became the target region for KFU in 2019 when it comes to the enhancement of the potential of its academic export. The cooperation with these countries is being developed in the framework of Eurasian Economic Union, interstate agreements at the level of the Russian Federation and owing to the consolidation of economic and socio-humanitarian ties of the Republic of Tatarstan. Bilateral academic mobility of staff members and students, implementation of joint educational programs, participation at research and academic events, holding career-guidance events and subject Olympiads have outlined the main spheres of partnership. The increase of the amount of international students from Central Asia served an outcome of the active promotion of the KFU brand in the region: in the reporting year 6739 students from Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and Turkmenistan studied at KFU (70% of the total percentage of international students).

In 2019 in the framework of the events oriented at the **international students recruitment** KFU took part in **11** international educational exhibitions and publicity tours, including:

- The 31st Annual EAIE Conference, September 24-27, 2019, Helsinki, Finland;
- 13th Azerbaijan International Education Exhibition, October 10-12, 2019, Baku, Republic of Azerbaijan;
- International exhibition and scientific conference "Education and sport in the epoch of power and happiness", November 14-15, 2019, Ashkhabad, Republic of Turkmenistan:
- Days of Russian Education in Finland and Estonia (under the auspices of Rossotrudnichestvo), November, 30 December, 01 2019, Helsinki, Finland, Tallin, Estonia.

Apart from that, the external advising sessions dedicated to the admission issues were organized in Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan. Currently Kazan Federal University possesses **62** agreements concluded with recruiting agencies, the majority of which operate on the territory of Asian, Latin American, Middle Eastern countries.





As an active participant of the "Export of Education" Federal project Kazan Federal University obtained governmental support for implementation of the project "Leading information campaign to attract foreign nationals to study at institutions carrying out educational activities in higher education programs, including on the terms of targeted training" (State Contract № 075-15-2019-1806 of November 22, 2019).

Project's aim is to form a positive image of Russia and Russian education as well as to attract foreign nationals to getting Russian university degrees through the international promotion of regional education system of the Republic of Tatarstan and Kazan city as one of the top student and sports center in the world.

Information campaign, oriented at the creation of a favourable image of Russia and Russian education and attracting foreign nationals to pursue studies in Russia, including the organization of

the events on informational coverage of the export potential of Russian higher education institutions, embraced the following activities:

- holding meetings and newsworthy events (press conferences, advertising campaigns, expert interviews, etc.);
- establishing direct contacts and celebrate joint events with leading centers of secondary education (schools) from abroad;
- organizing and holding events, oriented at the selection of talented prospected students at the target regions and countries through international Olympiads;
- joint campaigns with Russian and foreign organizations, involved into the process of international recruitment.
- joint events with regional organisms (structures) of the Republic of Tatarstan through representative offices and trade houses abroad;
 - joint events with foreign representative offices and consulates at the Republic of Tatarstan;
 - making publications in the media (printed press, digital media, Internet) based on the already celebrated and prospective events.

Main results of the program:


- Design of the concept of an information campaign under the implementation of the "Export of education" Federal project.
- Design of the concept of an information campaign in the framework of a regional project at the level of Republic of Tatarstan.
- Design of the methodology of conducting social research applicable to the media image of a university.
- Analysis of Russia's media-image at the priority countries for Russian academic export and media presence of the top Russian Universities at home and foreign media and Internet platforms.
- Creation of media and Internet platforms database for materials dissemination in the framework of information campaign.
 - Design of a media plan template for 2020 information campaign of Russian universities for 2020
- Information campaign celebration that embraced the design and use of the information materials and footage in Russian, English, Chinese languages.
- Drawing up recommendations on the enhancement of the results in the field of information support of export potential of Universities and the implementation of the "Export of education"
 Federal project.

Analytical materials designed in the course of the project and the results of works were presented and discussed at four working sessions involving the participation of the expert group's members, as well as representatives of the The Federal Agency for the Commonwealth of Independent States, Compatriots Living Abroad, and International Humanitarian Cooperation (Rossotrudnichestvo), representatives of the regional authorities, top Russian Universities – participants of 5-100 Project and other Russian universities, participants of the "Export of education" Federal project, top Russian and international experts in the field of higher education management, representatives of Russian and foreign media.

The countries of Central Asia (first and foremost, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan), China and Finland were chosen as the target regions for carrying out the information campaign of Tatarstan Universities. The choice of these regions and countries owes to the fast developing relations between Russia and BRICS countries (China) as well as CIS countries

(Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan), and to the active evolvement of cultural cooperation with national diasporas, residing in various European countries (like Finland, for instance). Moreover, the regions and countries, traditionally having vast representation among international students of the Universities of the Republic of Tatarstan were taken into account.

In the framework of the promotional strategy for target regions and countries during the course of the project an effective interaction system of all key regional factors in the sphere of international students' recruitment was built: regional universities – participants of the project, regional authorities, Russian and foreign partner organizations, including media.



Kazan Federal University continues developing international cooperation in the sphere of design and implementation of **joint** (**network**) **academic programs**. In the reporting year **54** joint academic programs, including **31** main academic programs (Bachelor, Master and Postgraduate studies), leading to obtaining double degree in partnership with top international universities, scientific organizations and companies were carried out. Altogether **275** students and postgraduates, including **163** international ones, took double degree programs at KFU in 2019; at the same time **12** Russian and international graduates obtained diplomas of KFU and partner universities.

Meanwhile KFU is constantly increasing the number of **academic programs in the foreign** (English) language – 23 Bachelor, Master, Specialist and Postgraduate programs of this type were carried out at KFU in the reporting period with 3 new programs (Bachelor and Master levels) launched in 2019. The Bachelor program "Economics and international business", implemented at the Institute of management, economics and finance in English language and having 58 students, including 10 international ones, is worth a special mentioning. The peculiarity of this project is in the fact that starting from the second year KFU students get the opportunity of pursuing online studies at London School of Economics and Political Sciences (UK). Upon successful completion of the examination tasks, the students get double diploma at graduation.

The growing amount of academic programs, possessing **international accreditation**, also influences the recruitment of international students. **2** Master programs of the KFU Institute of management, economics and finance obtained the accreditation of the leading international agencies in 2019:

- "Accounting, audit and financial consulting" program was recognized by The Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ACCA) (accreditation valid for the period of 2021-2025);
 - "Business and management" program was recognized by the Chartered Institute of

Management Accountants (CIMA).

The total number of academic programs carried out at KFU in 2019 and possessing international accreditation makes 19.

KFU continues an active cooperation with international companies in the framework of **supplementary professional education** development. As per the Contract for advanced training signed in 2018 with the Cuban company Tecnomatica (CUPET), 154 directors and specialists of the Company took studies at KFU in 2019 (KFU Center for advanced training, quality management and marketing acted as the academic organizer). The staff members of oil companies from Kazakhstan and Belarus participated at the mobile training programs.



One of the priority areas of the KFU international cooperation development is the increase of the international mobility programs. 803 international students from 37 countries (except for the international students enrolled at the main academic programs) were recruited for studying at KFU in the reporting period in the framework of international mobility increase. The most fruitful collaboration in the field of student mobility is carried out with the Universities of China, Japan, Germany, Republic of Korea, Kazakhstan, and Italy. 18 new agreements, aimed at the student exchange between KFU and top international universities of Germany, Spain, Japan, Turkey, Uzbekistan and other countries as well as the increase of incoming student mobility were signed in the reporting period.

ACADEMIC MOBILITY OF KFU STAFF AND STUDENTS

The increase in participation of KFU staff and students at the programs of **international academic mobility** is achieved through general University exchange agreements with 92 universities from 26 countries under Erasmus+ Program, as well as "Algarysh" Grant program of the Republic of Tatarstan Government jointly with DAAD German Academic Exchange Service. **291** KFU students obtained funds for participation at the KFU international mobility programs, including **254** students granted scholarships for studies and internships at Partner Universities in the framework of academic exchange agreements.

In the framework of various academic mobility programs **943** visits abroad of Kazan Federal University staff members involving the participation of **510** academic and scientific staff members took place in the reporting period. KFU staff members visited **445** foreign educational and scientific organizations from **68** countries, including **84** leading universities and organizations that enter TOP 400 of various international University rankings such as QS, ARWU, THE and others.

Most visits of KFU staff members were organized to the following countries: Germany (100 people), Uzbekistan (65 people), Great Britain (54 people), Kazakhstan (52 people), Turkey (44 people), China (41 people), Italy (39 people), Spain (38 people), Tajikistan (36 people), Japan (35 people), USA (32 people), France and Czech Republic (27 people each).

In the reporting period international academic mobility of scientific and pedagogical staff members took the following forms:

- advanced training/ research stay (carrying out research, material collection for scientific research, getting to know breakthrough research methods) 303 visits;
- delivering advanced training and professional retraining programs (reading lectures, carrying out supplementary professional educational programs, educational programs design, discovering educational technologies and teaching methods, participation at language internships, etc.) 44 visits;
- another categories of academic mobility, approved by the University legal acts, establishing the necessary procedure for academic mobility (participation at scientific events, administrative visits, negotiations and others) **596** visits.

In the reporting period there was the increase in participation of the University staff members at the advanced training programs, including research stays at the following leading foreign Universities: *Belgium* (University of Leuven), *Great Britain* (Oxford University, University of Cambridge, London School of Economics and Political Science, University of Nottingham), *Germany* (Humboldt University Berlin, Ludwig-Maximilian University, Technical University Dresden, Free University of Berlin), *Singapore* (National University of Singapore, Nanyang University of Technology), *USA* (Yale University, Cornell University, Texas A&M University), *Finland* (University of Helsinki), *France* (University of Grenoble-Alpes), *Switzerland* (Swiss Federal Institute of Technology), *Japan* (Tokyo University of Technology, University Okayama, Kyoto University) and others.

One of the mechanisms that has been most actively developed is the grant support under international, national and regional academic mobility programs. In the framework of "Algarysh" Grant program for studies and internships abroad belonging to the Government of the Republic of Tatarstan 15 visits of KFU staff members to the Universities of Germany, France, USA, Great Britain, Belgium and Finland were organized in 2019. 26 KFU staff members had short-term internships at Partner Universities of Great Britain, Czech Republic, Poland, Turkey, Belgium and Spain under Erasmus+ exchange programs.



KFU INTERNATIONAL STAFF

731 international experts from **63** countries visited KFU in 2019 for various purposes, among them 52 specialists arrived for research, 79 – for lectureship, 382 – for participation in scientific and educational events held at KFU, 218 – within the framework of administrative visits, for negotiations and other purposes. The biggest number of international staff came from People's Republic of China (129), Germany (67), Iraq (62), Japan (51), UK (47), USA (28), Poland (26), France (25), India (20).

Within the reporting period **121** foreign specialists, namely professors, teachers and researchers worked at Kazan Federal University for more than 6 months.




INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH ACTIVITY

In 2019 KFU staff members participated in **77** major **international research and academic projects** in cooperation with international organizations, functioning in the field of science and education, for example:

- Small molecule stabilizers/activators of mutant p53 (2019-2020), together with University of Southampton (United Kingdom), within the framework of joint grant of Russian Foundation for Basic Research (RFBR) and The Royal Society, (London, UK);
- Damage recovery Management Information System for Floods and Landslides with Distributed Heterogeneous Group of Robots (2019-2021), together with Kyoto University (Japan) and Mahidol University (Thailand), within the framework of RFBR grant;
- Digital economy in Russia and abroad: legal control, perspectives of global integration (2019-2021), together with University of California (USA), Goethe University Frankfurt (Germany) and University of Kiel (Germany), within the framework of grant of Russian Science Foundation (RSF);
- Classroom Cultural Diversity Climate (2019-2021), together with University of Potsdam (Germany), within the framework of grant of German Research Foundation (DFG) and others.

Within the reporting period KFU scholars continued participation in **12** international scientific collaborations. Among them:

- LearningToTeach in cooperation with universities of USA and Great Britain –
 International networked study supported by the World Association for Educational Research (WERA);
- FANTOM Global Scientific Consortium (includes 48 scientific organizations from more than 20 countries), aimed at creating an atlas of gene expression in all cells and tissues of the human body;
- ThEOR International platform for creation and distribution of revolutionary "green" EEE-technologies of in-situ oil refining, bringing together 300 specialists from 47 companies and universities of 12 countries (Russia, China, USA, Canada, France, Turkey, Denmark, Indonesia and countries of Latin America);
- Spectrum-Roentgen-Gamma International Russian-German orbital observatory project.

In 2019 **25 scientific units,** founded in cooperation with international organizations and scholars, were functioning in KFU. Among them: joint laboratory KFU-RIKEN Translational Genomics Unit (in cooperation with RIKEN, Japan), Center for Translational Medicine KFU-RASA (in cooperation with University of Pennsylvania and Fox Chase Cancer Center, USA), International Associated Laboratory "Developmental Neurobiology" (in cooperation with INSERM INMED, France), Research laboratory "Space Navigation and Planetary Studies" (in cooperation with Shanghai Astronomical Laboratory, China, National Astronomical Observatory of Japan, Abastumani Astrophysical Observatory, Georgia, Laboratory of high-speed calorimetry (in cooperation with the University of Rostock, Germany) and others.



Scholars of the Institute of Chemistry of KFU and RIKEN (Japan) developed a promising method of drug delivery to cancer cells with the use of ruthenium. The results of their work were published in Nature Catalysis https://www.nature.com/articles/s41929-019-0317-4

International project "Magnetic resonance study of gas diffusion in nanoporous materials: the effect of gas-wall interactions" became one of the seven winners of the RSF competition "Research, Conducted by International Research Teams" in cooperation with ANR (National Research Agency), France.

Project team consists of staff members of the Magnetic Resonance and Quantum Electronics research laboratory of the Institute of Physics of KFU and Laboratoire Kastler Brossel of Ecole Normale Superieure





Scholars of KFU, FEFU (Far East Federal University) and Mayo Clinic (USA) developed unique spinal rehab technology. The work is a continuation of a research published Nature Medicine, which showed the possibility of enabling motor activity after complete spinal cord injury



According to the results of 2018 journal "Russian Mathematics" became the first journal on mathematics among publications of Russian educational institutions to enter Q2 of Scopus database



Kazan Federal University is a ground for large-scale **international events**, many of which were held in Russia for the first time. KFU hosted **96** international scientific conferences, seminars and symposia in 2019. The following events can be mentioned among the largest and most representative, specifically by the number of international participants:

12th International conference IEEE Developments in e-Systems Engineering (DeSE) (October 7-10, 2019) – 257 participants (100 international participants) – Higher School of Information Technologies and Intelligent Systems. The conference was organized in cooperation with Liverpool John Moores University, IEEE association and Naberezhnye Chelny Institute of KFU, having a status of a conference supported by IEEE association.

International conference "Modern Geometry and its Applications – 2019" (September 4-7, 2019) – 117 participants (35 international participants) – Nikolai Lobachevsky Institute of Mathematics and Mechanics of KFU.

IV International Forum on Teacher Education (IFTE-2019) (May 28-30, 2019) – 760 participants (90 international participants) – Institute of Psychology and Education of KFU.

Fourth meeting of authors of "IPCC Special Report on the Ocean and Cryosphere in a Changing Climate" (March 3-9, 2019) – 150 participants (140 international participants) – Institute of Environmental Science of KFU.

Kazan Golovkinsky Stratigraphic Meeting 2019 "Late Paleozoic Sedimentary Earth Systems: Stratigraphy, Geochronology, Petroleum Resources" (September 24-28, 2019) – 229 participants (15 international participants) – Institute of Geology and Petroleum Technologies of KFU.

XI International Conference "Near-Earth Astronomy and Space Heritage" (September 30 – October 4, 2019) – 180 participants (28 international participants) – Institute of Physics of KFU. The Conference was organized in cooperation with the Russian Academy of Science.

The Third Symposium of the BRICS Association on Gravity, Astrophysics and Cosmology (29.09-3.09.2019) – 179 participants (38 international participants) – Institute of Physics of KFU with the support of BRICS Association on Gravity, Astrophysics and Cosmology.

The conference was organized under the auspices of the Government of the Republic of Tatarstan,




COOPERATION DEVELOPMENT

Development of strategic partnership and networking with world's leading research, educational and innovative organizations is one of the key objectives of KFU. Within the reporting period another **102** agreements were signed. As a result at the moment KFU is cooperating with **408** international partner universities, research and academic centres and companies from **70** countries.


One of the reasons for a considerable amount of official visits of international delegations to KFU is that 45th WorldSkills Competition was held in Kazan in 2019.

In 2019 THE launched a new global ranking, **THE Impact Rankings**, that captures the impact of higher education on delivering United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals. KFU entered TOP 100 occupying **37**th position in impact ranking for "Climate action".

In 2019 KFU was ranked 783 in the world prestigious ranking U.S. News Best Global Universities. It has also moved up in the subject rankings on Physics - 514, and Chemistry - 482. At the same time KFU strengthened its position in the world **TOP 150** universities in the *Space Sciences* subject area (114th position).

THE Digital Transformation Forum was held on November 26-27, 2019 in Kazan Federal University within the framework of cooperation with the Times Higher Education. The forum was attended by 140 participants. There were representatives of Russian and foreign universities, international ranking agencies, major foreign companies and mass media from Russia, UK, Finland, China, Kazakhstan, Turkey and other countries among the list of participants.


