6. Develop recommendations to improve the quality of specialists' work, based on the discussions and conclusions of the seminar.

Main areas discussed during the event:

1. Contemporary trends in professional education: analysis of current trends in the education system and training of specialists working with people with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), including new methods, technologies, approaches, and programs that foster the development of professional skills.

2. Technological innovations and new tools: consideration of the impact of modern technologies on professional competencies, including the use of digital resources, online platforms, and tools to increase the efficiency of specialists' work.
3. Innovative strategies for training and professional development: best practices for professional qualification improvement of specialists working with ASD population;
4. The specialist's personality: issues of psychological and professional readiness of specialists working with people with ASD.

Main areas discussed during the event:

In the context of the growing relevance of the autism issue and the need for effective support for people with ASD, this seminar will provide a unique platform for mutual assistance, knowledge exchange, practical skills, and innovations among specialists working with this group of people. There will be discussions of scientific research, best practices, and methods aimed at the qualitative application of established and developing professional competencies among specialists to improve the quality of life for individuals with autism and their families. Join us for the discussion of key issues and the joint search for solutions.
