

Steps of the exam (all steps on the platform kpfu.ru)

1. You take exam MCQ (minimum is 28 points from 50)

Less than 28 points
FAILED

28 points and more

Sum your semester points and exam points

Less than 56 points

Over 56 points
PASSED

2. You have to take controls (the same day after exam MCQ)

2a. If you have "0" for the control, the new points will be simply added to your total score

2b. If you have points for this control, the previous points will be cancelled, and new ones will be added

Count points (if it is needed, you can do more than 1 control)

Less than 56 points
FAILED

Over 56 points
PASSED

2nd chance

You have to do the whole procedure again
(it will be in autumn, at the beginning of the next semester)

NB! exam MCQ points are not saved

Grades:

Less 56 – failed

56-70 – "satisfied"

71-85 – "good"

86 and more – "excellent"

The general information about the exam MCQ

1. Number of questions – 85 (80 questions of types A+ and C, 5 questions of type B)
2. Time for exam MCQ – 90min
3. Types of questions:
 - A+ (several correct answers) – 0,5 points
 - C (match different statements) - 0,5 points
 - B (open question, you should type the correct answer) - 2 points

ATTENTION! The exam is on the 16th of June at 9 am SHARP (Moscow time zone)

The exam MCQ must be started at 9:00 - 9:10 sharp! The MCQ should be finished by 10:40 (the latest), after that time we will not accept any of the results. The MCQ can be done only once, otherwise, none of the attempts will be accepted.

Example of question type A+:

1. What of the following muscles provide flexion in the hip joint:

- a) m. iliopsoas
- b) m. rectus femoris
- c) m. sartorius
- d) m. gluteus maximus
- e) m. biceps femoris

Example of question type C:

1. Match the branches of internal and external iliac arteries (here is the example with answers):

- a) a. umbilicalis – a. iliaca interna
- b) a. pudenda interna – a. iliaca interna
- c) a. circumflexa ilium profunda – a. iliaca externa
- d) a. epigastrica inferior – a. iliaca externa

Example of question type B:

During the hysterectomy (uterine removal surgery), the doctor ligated the uterine artery, which passes through the broad ligament of the uterus.

Attention! There are 3 questions, you should type the correct answer consequently for all of the questions as ONE number (without gaps, comma, etc. for example, 125912). DO NOT change the order, otherwise, it will not be recognized as correct answer).

Question 1. What anatomical structure passes close to uterine artery and can be damaged during uterine artery ligation?

- 1) ureter
- 2) external iliac artery
- 3) a. rectalis superior
- 4) a. vesicalis inferior

Question 2. What are the ligaments of the uterus?

- 5) lig. latum
- 6) lig. cardinale
- 7) lig. teres uteri
- 8) lig. ovarii proprium
- 9) lig. suspensorium ovarii

Question 3. The uterine arteries reach uterus in portion, called:

- 11) Fundus uteri
- 12) Corpus uteri
- 13) Cervix uteri

Correct answer is 156713

After the exam MCQ, we will check the answers and count your points. We will inform you about the results.

2 hours after the exam MCQ, we will open access to the controls only for students who **got 28 or more points for the exam MCQ** and needs extra points **to get a minimum of 56 points**.

The control will be via the same online platform (virtual auditory of KFU).

Access to the controls will be opened according to the following schedule only:

12:00 – Control Osteology

13:00 – Control Myology

14:00 – Control Splanchnology

15:00 – Control Circulatory System

Each control – 50 questions for 30 minutes – 9 points maximum

In case you passed the exam and want to improve your grades (for example, you got “satisfied” and want “good”), you should be prepared for a **video-call** on the same exam day with examiner via the platform Microsoft Teams. Your previous points for the control will be cancelled. If your new points for the control are lower, than it was in the semester, in this case, your final grade will be worse.

Mandatory requirements for the video-call (during the whole control!):

- 1) Working properly microphone and camera (we should see your working space with blank paper and pencil only, your hands should be on the table)
- 2) Nobody should be in the same room as you
- 3) Before the control starts, you should show the examiner your passport (page with photo).

If these requirements are not fulfilled, the control will be stopped and will not be repeated.
