DOCTORAL PROGRAMS

The institute offers doctoral degree programs for those willing to conduct research and obtain a Candidate of Science Degree (PhD). The program includes independent research that leads to the preparation for and public defense of a dissertation. Duration of Study: 3 years (+ 1 year of Preparatory courses in the Russian language for postgraduate studies, if needed). Entry requirements: a specialist's diploma or a master's degree (second level of university education). If Russian is not your first language then proof of proficiency in the Russian language (TORFL-2) is required.

ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

The history of the Institute of Philology and Intercultural Communication dates back to the foundation of Kazan Imperial University in 1804. Today, the Institute is one of the largest schools of KFU with about 4000 undergraduate and graduate students and 300 faculty and staff members including over 1000 international students from China, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Turkey, The Czech Republic, Germany, USA, UK and other countries.

We train experts in linguistics, literature, Russian, Tatar and foreign languages (English, French, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, Turkish), interpreting and translating, educational technologies, design, arts and pedagogy in secondary schools and universities. We offer double majors (e.g., Russian + English), courses taught in English, as well as bachelor and master programs for international students interested in learning Russian as a foreign language. We grant bachelor, master and doctoral degrees.
